Strategic Planning

Strategic planning begins with a Troop's Mission Statement. The mission statement is the Troop's guiding principal.

Strategic Planning

Upon the completion of the Troop's election, the newly elected Senior Patrol Leader works with the Scoutmaster to create their Vision Statement.

The SPL's vision statement creates an overview of how their leadership, over their leadership term, will further the Troop towards our mission statement.



Strategic Planning

The Senior Patrol and Assistant Senior Patrol Leaders will formulate their objectives and goals to meet the vision statement.

They will use the SMART method to write their goals and objectives.

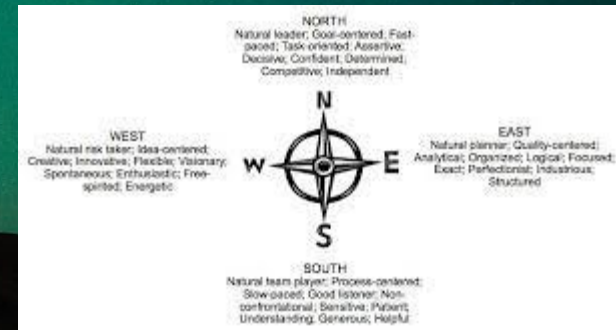
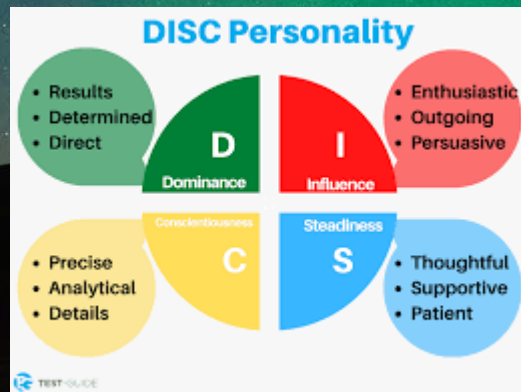
Monthly PLC Meetings are used to review and track these goals and objective to see if they are being met.

Troop works with our scouts to identify their strengths and weaknesses in their leadership.

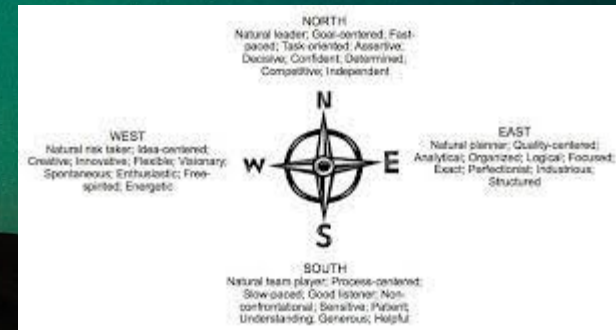
Troop has used two different types of leadership personality tests to help identify their leadership strengths and weaknesses.



Personal Leadership



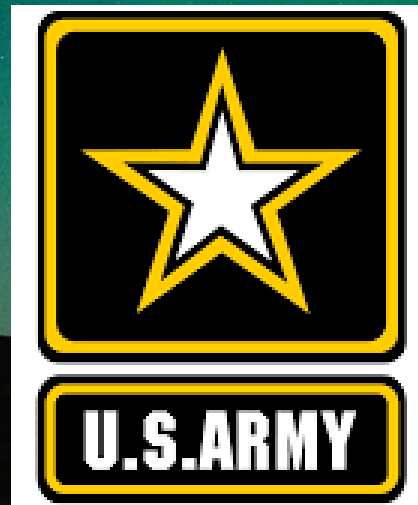
Upon learning their strengths and weaknesses, they scouts can better provide leadership to the Troop, to school, to home and their community.
