It is not a church service


- And it is not tied to any one religion

Key Features

- Short 10 – 15 minutes
- Youth Led – planned and presented by Scouts
- Inclusive – open to all beliefs and backgrounds
- Themed – planned around ideas like teamwork, nature, peace or thankfulness
- Flexible – Can include readings, poems, quotes, songs, silence or symbolic activities





When used

At Camp (morning or evening)

At the end of a big event

During a hike or outdoor moment

At ceremonies or special occasions


Anytime a troop wants to pause and reflect
